Day 1 Istanbul

Saturday. Welcome to Istanbul! On arrival, transfer to our hotel. Overnight - Istanbul.

Day 2 Istanbul

Today we explore Istanbul's Old City, the former seat of power for the Byzantine and Ottoman Empires. Our tour includes a visit to the striking Blue Mosque, Hagia Sofia, the Hippodrome and impressive Topkapi Palace. Overnight - Istanbul.

Day 3 Gallipoli - Canakkale

We travel to Gallipoli to pay our respects at some of the WW1 battlefields and memorials which dot the landscape. Visit ANZAC Cove and the memorials of Lone Pine and Chunuk Bair. Continue to the Nek and Johnstone's Jolly, then board the ferry to cross the Dardanelles en route to our hotel. Overnight - Canakkale.

Days 4 Troy – Pergamum – Kusadasi Journey south to Troy where we see the ruins of the fabled city and the replica Trojan horse. Continue to the famous ruins



of Pergamum, which is home to one of the steepest amphitheatres in the classical world. Overnight - Kusadasi.

Day 5 Ephesus

Today we enjoy a tour of the legendary Roman ruins of Ephesus. See the Library of Celsus, the Vedius Gymnasium and the Stadium in this ancient marble city. Later we see a carpet weaving demonstration en route to our hotel. Overnight - Kusadasi.

Day 6 Pammukale - Hierapolis

Leaving Kusadasi, we drive to the famous terraced pools and hot springs of Pamukkale. Walk along the travertines and enjoy a dip in the thermal bath house before we continue to the ruined Roman spa town of Hierapolis. Overnight - Pamukkale.

Day 7 Istanbul

Friday. Early this morning we transfer to Denizli airport for our flight back to Istanbul where our tour concludes. Visit our website for information about departure flight times.

Day 1 Istanbul

Saturday. Welcome to Turkey! Arrive in Istanbul and transfer to our hotel. Overnight - Istanbul.

Day 2 Istanbul

Enjoy a guided tour of the Old City, from where the Byzantine and Ottoman Empires were ruled. Marvel at the stunning Blue Mosque and visit other highlights including the Hippodrome, Hagia Sofia and Topkapi Palace. Overnight - Istanbul.

Day 3 Gallipoli - Canakkale

We travel to Gallipoli today and pay our respects at some of the many WW1 memorials and battlefields which dot the area. Our tour takes in ANZAC Cove as well as the Lone Pine and Chunuk Bair memorials, battlefield sites and cemeteries. Overnight - Canakkale.

Day 4 Troy - Pergamum - Kusadasi

Explore the fabled city of Troy this morning, which dates back to 3000BC. See the replica Trojan horse before we continue to Pergamum, home to one of the steepest amphitheatres in the classical world. Then we visit a local carpet emporium en route to coastal Kusadasi. Overnight - Kusadasi.

Days 5 Ephesus

Today we enjoy a guided tour of ancient Ephesus with its incredible marble ruins, including the Temple of Serapis and the spectacular Library of Celsus. En route

back to Kusadasi we visit the quaint Greek village of Sirince for a carpet weaving demonstration. Overnight - Kusadasi.

Day 6 Pamukkale - Marmaris

Explore the Roman spa town of Hierapolis and arrive at the famous hot springs of Pamukkale. Admire the surreal landscape, walk the beautiful travertines and opt for a dip in the thermal bath house. Later we visit a leather house and continue to Marmaris. Overnight - Marmaris.

Day 7 Marmaris

Friday. Our tour concludes today.

Days 1 & 2 Istanbul

Day 3 Canakkale

Transfer to Gallipoli and visit some of the sobering WW1 battlefields, trenches and memorials. Our first stop is ANZAC Cove, then we pay our respects at Lone Pine and Chunuk Bair memorials. Continue to the Nek and Johnston's Jolly. Overnight - Canakkale.

Days 4 & 5 Troy & Kusadasi

Explore fabled Troy and see a replica of the iconic wooden horse en route to the ruins of Pergamum. Admire one of the steepest amphitheatres in the classical world before we travel to Kusadasi.

On day 5 we explore the legendary marble ruins of Ephesus, including the Library of Celsus the Stadium and Vedius Gymnasium. Overnight - Kusadasi (2).

Day 6 Pamukkale

Explore the white terraced pools of Pamukkale and opt for a dip in the warm waters of the thermal bath before we visit the ruined spa town of Hierapolis. Overnight - Pamukkale.

Days 7 & 8 Cappadocia

On day 7 we visit some caravanserais en route to breathtaking Cappadocia. Explore the jewel in Turkey's crown on day 8 and marvel at the surreal landscape. We tour Goreme Valley, Zelve, Pigeon Valley and the incredible Uchisar castle-mountain. See the underground city of Kaymakli and visit an Onyx jewellery shop. Overnight -Cappadocia (2).

Days 9 & 10 Istanbul

We drive back to Istanbul on day 9 (flight upgrade available), before our tour ends the next day (Monday) with an airport transfer. Overnight - Istanbul (2).

Days 1 & 2 Istanbul

Saturday. Transfer to our hotel in Istanbul. On day 2 take in highlights on a guided tour, including the striking Blue Mosque, Hagia Sofia and stunning Topkapi Palace. Overnight - Istanbul (2).

Day 3 Gallipoli - Canakkale

We travel to Gallipoli to pay our respects at WW1 battlefields and memorials including ANZAC Cove, Lone Pine and Chunuk Bair. Continue to the Nek and Johnstone's Jolly. Overnight - Canakkale.

Days 4 & 5 Troy - Pergamum - Ephesus On day 4 we see the replica Trojan horse at Troy. Continue to the ruins of Pergamum and arrive in Kusadasi before we tour legendary Ephesus on day 5. Overnight - Kusadasi (2).

Day 6 Hierapolis - Pammukale

Visit the ruined spa town of Hierapolis and take a dip in the Pamukkale thermal pools. Overnight - Pamukkale.

Days 7 & 8 Fethiye - Blue Lagoon On day 7 we take a boat to Turtle Beach

and opt to visit a local mud bath en route to Fethiye. Day 8 finds us exploring the Greek village of Kayakov and swimming in the Blue Lagoon at Oludeniz. Overnight - Fethiye (2).

Day 9 Demre - Antalya

Leaving Fethiye, we drive to Demre where you can opt to explore the sunken city of

Kekova. Afterwards, we continue to Antalya. Overnight - Antalya.

Days 10 & 11 Konya - Cappadocia

Tour the Whirling Dervish Monastery at Konya on day 10 as we travel on the famous Silk Road. Explore stunning Cappadocia including Uchisar Castle and Kaymakli on day 11. Overnight - Cappadocia (2).

Days 12 - 14 Safranbolu - Istanbul

Opt for a hot air balloon ride over Cappadocia on day 12 then we travel to our mansion home in Safranbolu. On day 13 we tour the old town, then return to Istanbul to visit the Grand Bazaar. Our tour ends on day 14 (Friday) with an airport transfer. Overnight -Safranbolu (1), Istanbul (1).

After breakfast we head for Dubrovnik, the charming city which starred in hit TV show Game of Thrones. There's time to explore the city walls and winding narrow streets. Stop for a cold beer at one of the taverns which dot the city. Overnight - Dubrovnik.

Day 4 Sipan / Trstenik

Today we sail to either Sipan Island or Trstenik. Sipan was a historic summer getaway for Dubrovnik's elite and its quiet beaches are a great place to relax. Trstenik is a pretty fishing town and there are several beautiful coves and beaches to explore. Overnight - Sipan / Trstenik.

Day 5 Korcula

This morning we sail to Korcula, the birthplace of Marco Polo. Tucked away in the medieval walls of Korcula town you can find palaces, cathedrals and delightful cobbled streets. Overnight - Korcula.

Day 6 Pakleni Islands - Hvar

Today we cruise to the Pakleni islands and on to Hvar, the island famous for its lavender and wine. Stroll through the harbour town of the same name and enjoy delicious seafood. Overnight - Hvar.

Days 7 & 8 Brac - Split

Sail to Brac for a swim at Zlatni Rat Beach on day 7 before we return to Split for free time to explore. Perhaps visit Diocletian's Palace before your tour ends on day 8 (Saturday). Overnight - Split (1)

Day 1 Kilimanjaro - Arusha
